4.3 NUMBER OF COMPETITORS ACCEPTED AND CATEGORIES

4.3.1 Number of competitors accepted

The maximum number of entries for all categories is 60.

If more than 60 apply or after screening for eligibility, the organisers reserve the right to consider which to accept, and if your entry is not accepted, you will be notified.

4.3.2 Categories 1

- 1 Cars approved by JAF or FIA
- ② R, RJ, RPN, or AE as indicated in the 2021 JAF Sporting Regulations, chapter 2.
- ③ Classes

R-1 : Over 1600cc 4WD and Over 3000cc 2WD

R-2 : Over 1600cc and up to 3000cc 2WD

R-3 : Up to 1600cc and AE, or AT

4.3.3 Categories 2 (Historic Car Class)

- ① RF as indicated in the 2021 JAF Sporting Regulations, chapter 2.
- ② Cars as indicated in the Alpine Classic Car Rally (ACCR) Regulations.

4.4 ENTRY PACKAGE

4.4.1 Entry fee JPY175,000. / per rally car (incl. tax)

The above fee includes the participation fee, the reconnaissance fee, 1 road book, 2 official programme, 2 passes for entrants, 4 passes for service crews, 1 car pass and service space (5m x 5m).

4.5 APPLICATION FOR SERVICES

To register a service car, please fill out the application form prescribed by the organizer and submit it at the same time as your entry application.

- <u>Service car registration fee for the first car:</u> including in the entry fee, also registration fee for 4 service crews.
- Service car registration fee for the second car: JPY20,000.
 including additional space and registration fee for 2 additional service crews.
- * The additional registration of service crew only is JPY5,000. /per 1 crew.
- Accommodation and meals are not included in the price.
- * Only registered service vehicles are allowed to enter the service park.
- If you service more than one rally car with one service car, please inform it us when you apply for entry.









4.6 PAYMENT

- The payment will be made by bank transfer to our account.
- Only Japanese yen (JPY) will be accepted.
- All transfer fees are the responsibility of the competitor.

4.7 REFUND OF ENTR

Entry fees will be refunded in full in the following:

- > To candidates whose entry has not been accepted.
- In the case of the rally not taking place.

Partial Refund of Entry in the following:

- ➤ In the case of the organiser decide that the event cannot be held less than 15 days before the rally due to the impact of COVID-19 and its unstoppable spread continues to fiercely affect, at least 70% of entry fee will be refunded.
- In a case of force majeure, the Organizer will refund 50% of entry fee to competitor who are unable to run (as duly certified by their ASN).

5. INSURANCE

- Valid voluntary insurance (Insurance for the interpersonal object, damage such as the own loss, fellow passenger by the traffic accident) is required, must join it.
- The insurance benefits for the interpersonal object are JPY20 million or more, JPY2 million or more for property for damage such as the own loss, and JPY10 million or more for passengers.
- The JMRC mutual aid system(consolations) is also acceptable for passengers.
- For those who do not have insurance for competition, the Rally Secretariat will accept applications for insurance valid for this rally.
- Those wishing to apply for the above is required to fill in an order form in the entry booklet and send it to us.









6. ADVERTISING AND RALLY PLATE

6.1 WINDOW

Competitors are allowed to affix any advertising to their cars (including roof). However, only cars registered outside Japan are permitted to use a space at the top of the front windscreen.

Space for advertising:

Front window: 10 cm high from the top

Rear window: 8cm or less in high from the top

6.2 OPTIONAL ADVERTISING

Competitors who accept the organiser's optional advertising must reserve space for it as specified in the supplementary regulations Appendix VII. If a competitor declines this advertising must pay the entry fee in case of reject optional advertising.

6.3 RESTRICTIONS ON ADVERTISEMENTS

No regulations on advertising regarding rally car or wear in Japan, including advertising for alcoholic beverages and cigarettes.

6.4 RALLY PLATE AND COMPETITION NUMBERS

The organiser will provide each crew with rally plate and number identification package, comply with 2021 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations, Art.18, which must be affixed to their car in the stated positions according to the supplementary regulations prior to scrutineering. Penalties JPY54,000 are given for breaking the regulation.

7. TYRES

7.1 FOR ALL TYPES OF CARS AND ALL COMPETITORS

7.1.1 Tyres available

Tyres available that can be driven on public roads in Japan are required (exclude tyres for circuit).

7.1.2 Tyre quantities

The overall quantity of tyres to be used 20 at this event.

8. FUEL

During the period between after scrutineering and the finish of the rally, refuelling must be dispensed at service stations marked by the organizers in the Road Book.









9. RECONNAISSANCE

- Running of Reconnaissance must take place according to a timetable set on Saturday 12
 November, and under control by the organiser. All competitors are eligible.
- 2) Reconnaissance registration

Date: Thursday, 11 November, at 15:00-19:00 or Friday, 12 November, at 07:00-07:30 Place: Sub Rally HQ in Toyota Stadium

- * Note: Please receive reconnaissance card and car discrimination card.
- The details of reconnaissance schedule shall be in accordance with Supplementary Regulations Appendix 2.

9.1 RECONNAISSANCE CAR

The reconnaissance car must be painted in a single colour.

9.2 TYRE FOR RECONNAISSANCE CAR

All tyres used must be readily available commercially in Japan, and for general asphalt (exclude for competition).

9.3 RESPECT OF RECONNAISSANCE

- Each crew must affix the car discrimination card on reconnaissance car identification card during reconnaissance.
- 2) Each crew is limited to two passages on each special stage.

9.4 TRAFFIC LAWS AND REGULATION

- 1) All vehicles taking part in Central Rally must comply with and observe all the relevant domestic laws and regulations.
 - During reconnaissance, competitors must follow traffic laws and regulations, which will be further notified in the special rule book and official notices.
 - > They must follow any instructions by the organizer.
 - In all cases, must respect the safety and rights of other road users.
 - Officials may visually or by measuring instruments, photographs or video monitor the operation of the towing vehicles on the route.
 - All violations will be reported to the Stewards of the meeting and may punish in penalties up to and including the inability to start the rally.
- 2) The legal road speeds
 - During reconnaissance, must not be operated above the legal road speed limit on special stage and all roads.
 - All violations will be imposed penalties by the Stewards of the meeting.









10. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

10.1 DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- Driver's and Co-driver's competition licences and valid driving licences.
 *International visitors shall have a valid Japanese licence or International Driving Permit to drive on public roads in Japan.
- 2) ASN authorisation, for all foreign competitors and/or drivers.
- 3) Car registration/inspection certificate, compulsory automobile liability insurance card (referred to as "CALI", for short, "Jibaiseki" in Japanese) and valid insurance card for rally.
- 4) An original pledge document with signature.
- 5) Questionnaire for preventing infection of COVID-19

- 1) 2) 3) For prevent infection of COVID-19, Please accompany by a copy of the valid documents when you send the entry form by e-mail.
- 4) 5) Please submit at administrative checks in Toyota Stadium.

11. SCRUTINEERING / MARKING / SEALING / SAFETY ITEMS

11.1 RALLY CAR

- 1) All rally cars must be submitted for scrutineering (technical inspection) within the time specified in the timetable at the technical control area that specified by the organizer (Toyota Stadium). Date: Friday, 12th November 2021, at 9:30-15:00
- 2) If the car will not comply with the regulations, the Stewards may refuse the start. However, the Stewards may give them time to repair.
- 3) Equipment of the crews
 - The crew must wear helmets, racing suits and equipment in compliance with 2021 JAF Sporting Regulations Part 4, Appendix "Equipment of the crews in rally competitions". Also recommended to wear head and neck protection devices (FHR system, HANS, etc.).
- 4) Equipment of the cars
 - Each competing car must carry equipment below.
 - 2 x red reflective triangle, emergency signal lights, red light, towing ropes and first-aid kit
 - Fire extinguisher with specifications specified in 2021 JAF Sporting Regulations Part 2, Chapter 2, Article 3.









"SOS" "OK" sign measuring at A3 size.
 Note: The sign must be placed in the car and be readily accessible for both drivers.

- 5) Safety Emergency console (Tracking System)
 Safety tracking system will be planned to install in this rally. In such a case, we will inform you about equipment, rental fee, etc. in advance via communication.
- 6) On-board cameras
 - The competitor of any car which carries an on-board camera must to submit the application form when you apply to entry and have the prior agreement of the organiser.
 - Authorised cameras must be mounted by the time of scrutineering, regardless of whether the camera is mounted on the inside or outside of the car.
 - Permission stickers will be affixed by technical official during scrutineering. Shooting is prohibited if you do not have permission.
 - The copyright of the movies taken by that camera belongs to the organiser and may require to provide for the movies.

12. CEREMONIAL START

Date: Saturday, 13 November, at 09:00 (First car will start)

Place: TBA

The guest of honor will wave the start flag and the ceremonial start will start sequentially.

The start interval for a ceremonial start is at the discretion of the official.

13. PODIUM CEREMONY

Date: Sunday, 14 November 2021, around 17:50

Place: TBA

The (provisional) podium ceremony will be held after the rally and the crews positioned in the order high in provisional classification of each class will attend. Class and positions concerned will be announced,1st through to 6th or 1st through to 3rd, it depends on the class. Not eligible crews for ceremony drive directly to Parc Fermé.
